Greetings from my hermitage, day 130. I hope you are well and safe as the Covid cases in Georgia continue to rise. We will not support physical gatherings until further notice. Recent openings and get-togethers have caused much higher rates of Covid to emerge. Health experts advise to socially distance, wear masks and gloves, and wash hands. Let us all be considerate and compassionate to work together to stop the spread and support those in harm's way.

Growing up in the Panama Canal Zone I spent most of my time in the swimming pool training as a competitive swimmer. Lessons I learned then now support my practice of Centering Prayer:

1) It is important to keep at it even when we think we are going nowhere. 2) We will find a strength, a source within that is always with us. 3) When we put our whole heart and self into the effort, it makes all the difference.

Our goals in Centering Prayer are not to win trophies or set new records. The more we practice Centering Prayer, the nearer to God we come as our relationship deepens. I invite you to embrace the opportunity the pandemic is presenting to increase your practice. I have welcomed my self-isolation, increasing my CP time to at least two hours a day. The gifts are flowing! I am committed to continue this after the quarantine lifts. I am not proposing a hermitage for you, but new, freer schedules can open up opportunities for increased Centering Prayer. The closer we get to God, the clearer are our priorities, and the more we are able live Christ's way.

We can draw from these valuable gifts to help in the pandemic. We can be a guiding light of peace and wisdom for those ill, their caregivers, and all who are under stress. May we bring healing and harmony to the pain, suffering and disorder happening now through our prayers and compassion.

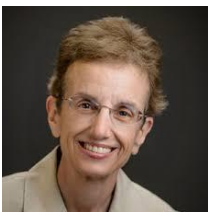
On the same last Saturday, **Fr. William Meninger**, our beloved surviving co-creator of the method of Centering Prayer, presented to 131 participants his last in a series of **Julian of Norwich**, hosted by Tallahassee Contemplative Outreach. His loving presentation of the incredibly valuable insights from Julian inspired us all. He reminded us we need humility as the key to dealing with the false self. Fr. On **Sunday, June 28th our Revolutionary Contemplatives group presented on Zoom through Mary and Martha's Place "Contemplative Way Stations"** - A conversation with Lerita Coleman Brown, Stuart Higginbotham, and Carl McColman, moderated by Rebecca Parker with musical interludes by Caroline Herring. Carl observed that Julian of Norwich has been a guiding light during this time. Lerita recommended Howard Thurman's

work can facilitate our contemplative response to two pandemics: racism and Covid. Stuart observed we are in a crucial time where inessentials are being burned away. He drew on Brother Roger's *Essential Writings* whose grounding vocation was to reconcile all people through Taizé.



On **Saturday, June 27th Fr. William Meninger** spoke to over 190 people all over the country in his second Zoom conference hosted by Tallahassee Contemplative Outreach. He described deep meanings for us today are found in **Julian of Norwich's** *Revelations of Divine Love*, revealing that God has created: infinite compassion, mercy, and love for us. He called Thomas Merton, Raimon Panikkar, and Teilhard de Chardin present-day living manifestations of Julian.



On **Friday, June 26th Ilia Delio** presented to over 1600 people from all over the world **"The God Revolution: Beyond Racism and the Remaking of Religion."** Despite a bike accident that caused a serious concussion, Ilia communicated her message clearly. She explained how the Adam myth that developed from the Genesis story is wrong. She encouraged us to create a new myth in a new direction that binds us together as Teilhard suggested, "Love is the core energy of the universe." Hopefully, we will soon see the recorded video, notes and slides.

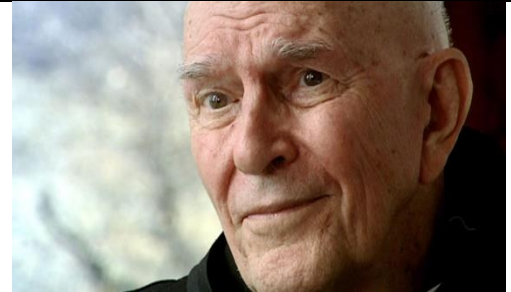
